Background

The LINC Academic Affairs Council (AAC) serves in a steering capacity within LINC. Leveraging annually developed program-specific interprofessional education (IPE) plans, the LINC AAC identifies—on an annual basis—opportunities for university-wide IPE collaboration, consensus, and quality improvement. The end product is a workplan intended to guide efforts for the following year. The list below represents priorities identified for calendar year 2024.

2024 Priorities

- 1. Develop 5-year goals to guide LINC's success for 2025-2029
- 2. Review the LINC operating and organizational models developed during the 2018-2023 QEP cycle and propose revisions to consolidate gains and ensure success over the next 5 years
- 3. Ensure the continued successful implementation, outcomes evaluation and dissemination, and long-term sustainability and impact of the university-wide <u>LINC Longitudinal IPE Program</u>
- 4. Support dissemination of outcomes from the university-wide <u>LINC Core IPE Measurement Plan</u> and develop recommendations to improve the actionability of annual analyses and reports
- 5. Review the complement of additional LINC programs and projects developed during the 2018-2023 QEP cycle and, for each, recommend continuation as is, continuation in a reimagined form, or discontinuation
