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1.6 ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

A medical school ensures that its medical education program meets all eligibility requirements of the LCME for initial and continuing accreditation, including receipt of degree-granting authority and accreditation by a regional accrediting body by either the medical school or its parent institution.

The University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio is accredited by Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC), 1866 Southern Lane, Decatur, GA 30033-4097, to award certificates and baccalaureate, master's, doctoral and professional degrees.

The University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio was reviewed by SACSCOC in March 2018. The SACSCOC Board reaffirmed the institution's accreditation at their annual meeting on December 9, 2018. A full 10 year accreditation term was approved and includes all programs offered on the institution's main campus as well as those offered at all extended program sites. .
